Our ongoing Projects:

 The CHICHO Forest and playaround, at the Home for children with mental retardation "Slunchitse" in **Gorski Senovets**

In April 2016 CHICHO donated 15 wild chestnut trees to be planted in the vard of Home "Slunchitse" in Gorski Senovets in an effort to engage the kids with nature. Later that year we donated another 200 trees due to the big success of the project. Next to the forest we also built a playground and a small football/ basketball court.





CHICHO House - Transitional Home:

Some years ago CHICHO renovated a house donated by the municipality of Gorski Senovets to be renovated and appropriated for the adolescents leaving the care home after turning 18. It provides shelter and serves as a safe transition into adulthood.



Hristo Lyubenov is 23 and is a real success story. He lived in care home "Slunchitse" where after exhibiting interest in music he started piano lessons. sponsored partly by CHICHO. Hristo will graduate the Sofia Music Academv after winning a full scholarship with his talent.

• "Granny and Child":

This has been our flagship project since 2011 and is currently running in the care home "Slunchitse" in Gorski Senovets, and in Stara Zagora in cooperation with association "Samaritans". The project aims to create a long-lasting, personal and

individualised relationship between children with severe disorders and adults. in this case retired or widowed senior women. These "grannies" are thus given the opportunity to work and be engaged in a meaningful job with a high social



value, where they also come to fulfil the function of a parent or grandmother to the child. This kind of regular, personal contact is believed to have a positive effect on the overall development of the child. Gradually the love and attachment grow and they inevitably become family.

• Karin Dom training center, Varna:

This project helps parents of children with special needs who are residing at a greater distance from Varna to commute to the training center and be able to follow the necessary therapies without interruptions, which could be detrimental to their progress.

Art exhibition in our office in Maastricht:



In October 2016 Ilia organised an art exhibition in his home of Bulgarian artist and loyal friend and supporter of CHICHO Doncho Donchev, A net profit of € 2,000 from the sale of his paintings and sculptures was transferred to the foundation's account.
